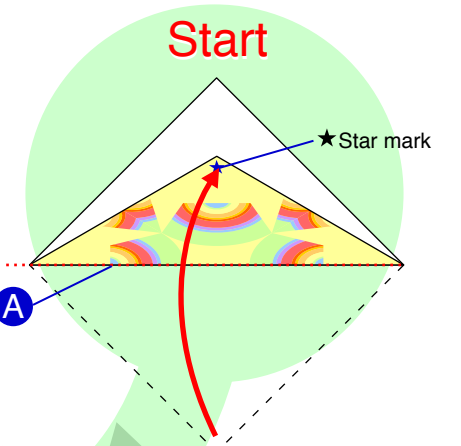


Horned box [A4 size 6pages]

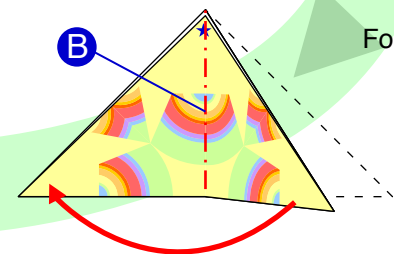
There are various types of origami which have been done in Japan since ancient times.

The Horned Box is an interesting box that can be used to hold potpourri or other small items. In Japan, it is sometimes used to hold candy along with doll displays for Girls' Festival.

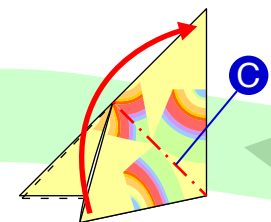
● The letters in blue circles indicate the fold lines. They are also shown on the practice sheet.



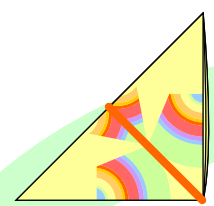
Fold in half along line A.



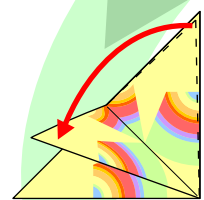
Fold in half again along line B.



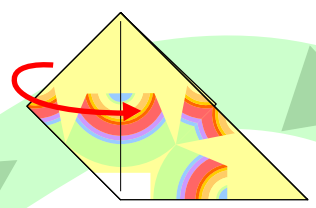
Fold the triangle on top in half along line C.



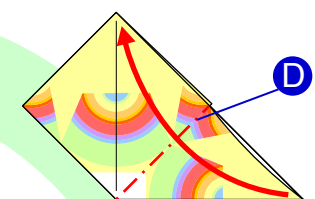
Flatten out the folds.



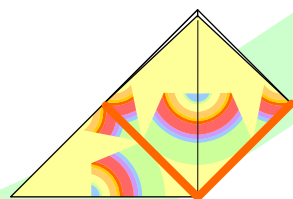
Unfold the triangle.



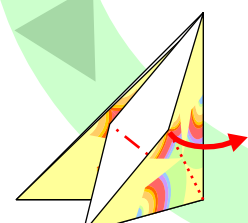
Turn over.



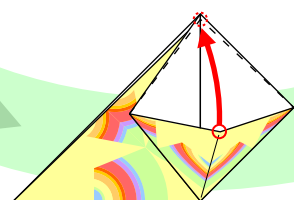
Fold the triangle up and to the right along line D, so that the point of the triangle meets the top corner of the diamond shape.



Flatten out the folds.



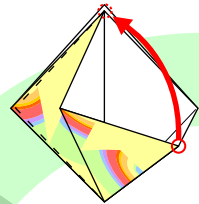
Open up the triangle.



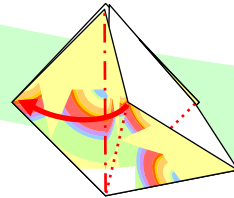
Flatten the triangle to obtain a square.

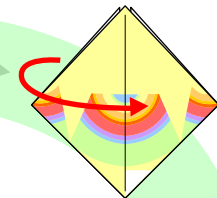
Fold along lines **E** and **F** to align the edges with the center line.



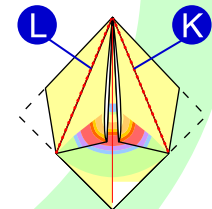
Lift up and open the triangle you folded along line **E**. Flatten the corner of the triangle inward along lines **G** and **H**.



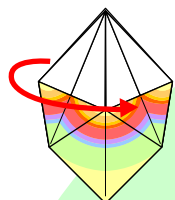
Lift up and open the triangle you folded along line **F**. Flatten the corner of the triangle inward along lines **I** and **J**.



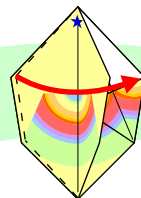
Turn over.



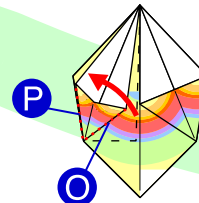
Fold along lines **K** and **L** to align the edges with the center line.



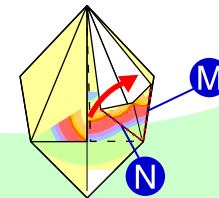
Turn over.



Fold the upper layer over to the left along the center line.



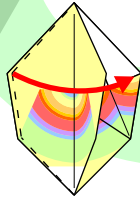
Lift up and open the triangle you folded along line **L**. Flatten the corner of the triangle inward along lines **O** and **P**.



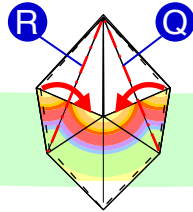
Lift up and open the triangle you folded along line **K**. Flatten the corner of the triangle inward along lines **M** and **N**.

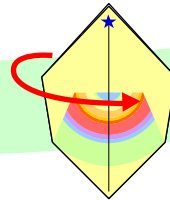

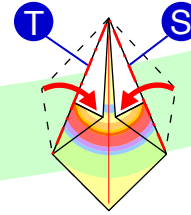
Fold the upper layer over to the left along the center line.



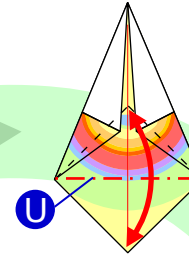
Fold along lines Q and R to align the edges with the center line.



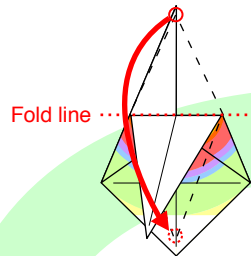
Turn over.



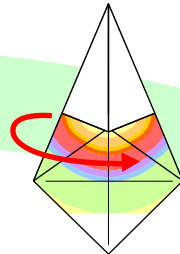
Fold along lines S and T to align the edges with the center line.



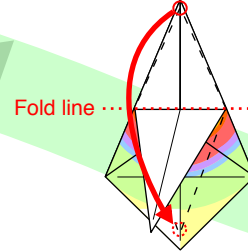
Fold upward along line U, crease, and unfold the triangle back to its original position.



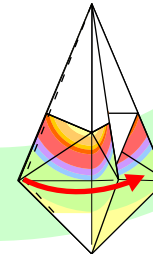
Fold the upper triangle downward along the fold line.



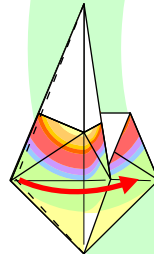
Turn over.



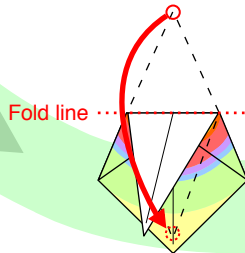
Fold the upper triangle downward along the fold line.



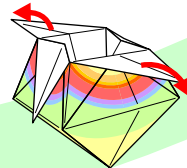
Fold the upper layer over to the left along the center line.



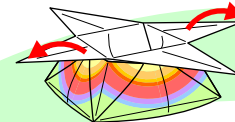
Fold the upper layer over to the left along the center line.



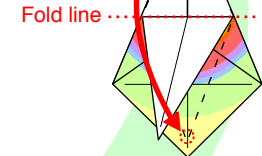
Fold the upper triangle downward along the fold line.



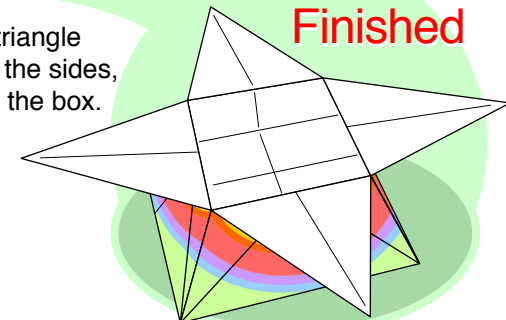
Lift up the triangles on opposite sides and pull back to open the mouth of the box. Open until the mouth of the box forms a square.



Lift out the other pair of triangle and pull back. Push out the sides, and flatten the bottom of the box.



Fold the upper triangle downward along the fold line.




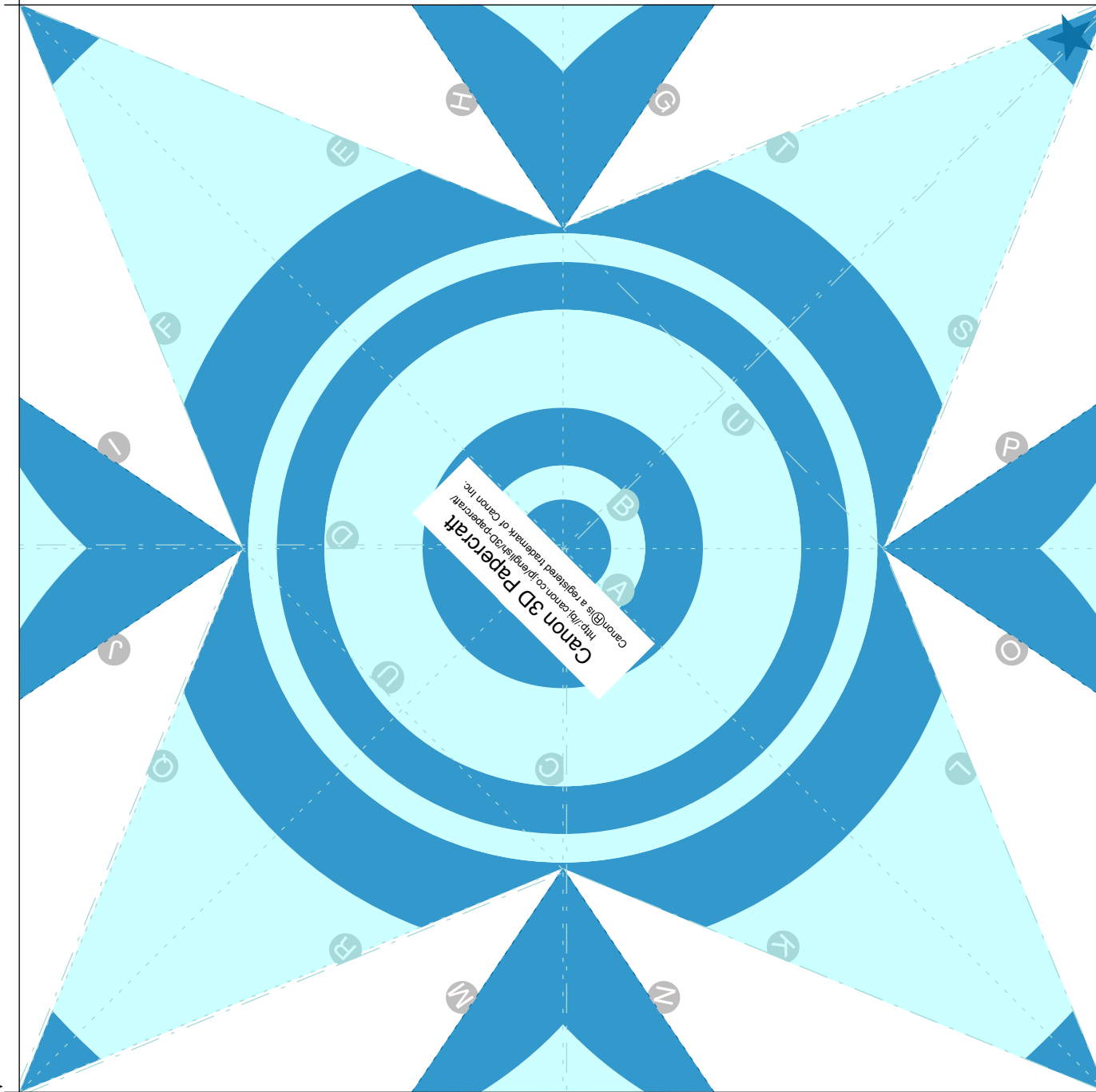
